ARTIST'S REQUIREMENTS:

- 1. Must have artist's name, address, phone number and title on back.
- 2. Must be picked up on the specified date and with-in the allocated time
- 3. Artwork that is sold may not be removed until the end of the exhibit, nor can it be replaced with another piece.
- 4. All pricing will be on cards provided and adjacent to artwork.
- Any declined artwork should be picked up ON January 30, 2023. If not picked up, then work will be returned to the SWFFCG storage closet at the CCAC. Artist understands that the SWFFCG nor CCAC have any responsibility for art work not picked up.
- 6. THE SOUTHWEST FLORIDA FINE CRAFT GUILD RESERVES THE RIGHT TO REJECT ANY WORK THAT IS POORLY PRESENTED AND DOES NOT MEET HANGING AND DISPLAY REQUIREMENTS AT THE TIME OF RECEIVING.
- Damaged pieces and pieces with unfinished details may be declined and removed from the exhibit at any time.
- Entries must be ready with all necessary hangers, Wall pieces must have wires that are wrapped, and no wires should be visible once pieces are installed. No saw-toothed hangers will be allowed.
- 9. Must be securely fastened with picture wire. The center of the wire should be a minimum of 3" from the top of the frame when stretched.
- 10. EXHIBIT REQUIREMENTS/GUIDELINES for 2D and 3D work are available on line on our website under "Peer Review Process".

- 11. Entry fees are \$20 for one piece, \$25 for two pieces and \$30 for three pieces . Please Note Entry fees are not refundable.
- 12. Cape Coral Art Center retains a 30% commission on sales. Please take this into consideration when pricing you work

RELEASE WAIVER & AGREEMENT

RESPONSIBILITY: While every effort will be made to handle artwork with care and protect it from loss, neither the Southwest Florida Fine Craft Guild nor the Cape Coral Art Center will be liable for damage or loss.

Submission of work for this exhibit and the signing of the Release Waiver will constitute an agreement to these conditions including honoring dates and times for receiving and removal and giving permission to allow photography for publicity purposes.

Artist agrees to all provisions of this prospectus and agrees that any person other than the artist delivering or removing their work has also read and agreed to the terms of this prospectus.
